

".....This is the case of Metal Stone Quarry. The case was recommended in 378 SEAC meeting dated 03-07-2019 and PP was called for presentation in 561st SEIAA meeting dtd. 08.08.2019 but PP could not present in the meeting for presentation. Meanwhile, a complaint letter dated 20.08.2019 received from Shri Rajesh Tiwari & villagers regarding submission of false and fake information about other mines in 500 m. periphery at village Jharkua, Tehsil - Amanganj, Dist. Panna. After discussion, it is decided to send the complaint to Collector Panna to seek clarification and verify factual status of other mines located in 500 m. periphery at village Jharkua, Tehsil - Amanganj, Dist. Panna from the above Metal Stone Quarry of Shri Prahalad Tiwari so that necessary action can be taken."

Since PP has not submitted above information and clarification from Collector, Panna is still awaited hence it has been decided to delist the case on the condition that if PP intends to present the case in SEIAA, it will then be relisted for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned."

As per above decision, you are hereby informed that your case is delisted and liable for relisting if you intends to present the case in SEIAA.


