Sub: Case No. 3307/2015 - Prior Environmental Clearance for **Dolomite Mine** (Open cast Manual/ Semi-Mechanised Method) in an area of 1.676 ha for Expansion in production capacity from 2000 Tonne/year to 12839 TPA at Khasra no. 400 at Village – Salaiya Tehsil - Murwara, District- Katni (M.P) by Shri Laxman Tiwari S/o Shri Saru Tiwari, Post – Badwara Khurd Tehsil - Murwara, District - Katni (MP) - 383504.

This has reference to your application received in SEIAA office on 23.06.2015 and subsequent letters seeking Prior Environmental Clearance for the above project under the EIA Notification, 2006. The proposal has been appraised as per prescribed procedure in the light of provisions under the EIA Notification, 2006 on the basis of the mandatory documents enclosed with the application viz., the Form - I, Pre-Feasibility Report, ToR and subsequently submission of EIA, Public Hearing proceedings and the additional clarifications furnished in response to the observations of the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) and State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) constituted by the competent Authority.

ii. It has been noted that the proposal is for **Dolomite mine** in an area of 1.676 ha. The mining lease area is located in Khasra no. 400 at Village – Salaiya Tehsil - Murwara, District- Katni (M.P.). Geographically mining lease area falls under the co-ordinates latitude 23°41'58.7" N to 23°42'04.9" N and longitude 80° 35'23.9" E to 80° 35'29.4" E. The nearest village Salaiya is located at a distance of 1.2 km. There is no National Park/Sanctuary and interstate boundary within 10 km radius.

The proposed project is for production capacity of **12,839 TPA**. The mining will be carried out by Opencast Manual / Semi -Mechanized Method. The Mining plan is approved by the IBM (vide letter no. MP /Katni /Dolomite /M.Sch - 33/ 2013-14 dtd. 03.01.2014). The 0.036 ha area shall be covered under plantation and 200 saplings shall be planted at the end of lease period.

iii. The project has been considered in accordance with the provisions of the EIA notification issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests vide S.O. 1533 (E), dated 14th September 2006.

iv. Based on the information submitted, as at Para (ii) above and others the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) considered the case in its 296th meeting dtd. 17.02.2016 and decided to accept the recommendations of 255st SEAC meeting dtd. 02.01.2016.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance for **Dolomite Mine** (Opencast Manual/ Semi-Mechanised Method) in an area of 1.676 ha for Expansion in production capacity from 2000 TPA to 12839 TPA at Khasra no. 400 at Village – Salaiya Tehsil - Murwara, District- Katni (M.P.), **for the lease period** to Shri Laxman Tiwari S/o Shri Saru Tiwari, Post – Badwara Khurd, Tehsil - Murwara,

District - Katni (MP) - 383504, subject to the compliance of following specific conditions as recommended by SEIAA & SEAC and subsequent Standard Conditions.

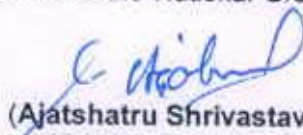
A. Specific Conditions

1. PP shall fence the entire ML area and develop a green belt by planting at least 400 plants around it in two rows.
2. A total of 0.28 ha area shall be covered under afforestation.
3. No crusher shall be installed at the mining site.
4. The 500 m long Village road along the ML area shall be maintained by PP, so as to minimize the emission of particulate matters and reduce the air pollution in the surrounding area. The plantation shall be carried out on either side of the road by PP.
5. Mining shall not be carried out below the water table.
6. Pumped out water of the mined out pits should be utilised for development of greenbelt.
7. Water samples of the existing pond, well, tube-well, handpump etc., within 500 m area of mining site should be tested annually via authorised water testing laboratory by PP.
8. Shed alongwith the first-aid facility shall be developed for the workers at mining site.
9. The PP shall undertake the following activities in nearby villages on priority in consultation with the respective Gram Panchayats and make separate budget provisions under the CSR for these activities:
 - a) Skill upgradation programme for the villagers of nearby villages.
 - b) Sanitation activities including construction of toilets in consultation with village Panchayat.
 - c) Installation of rainwater harvesting structure..
10. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department. The appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
11. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
12. Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
13. Necessary consents shall be obtained from MPPCB and the air pollution control measures for crusher have to be installed as per the recommendation of MPPCB.
14. Curtaining of site shall be done using appropriate media.
15. The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining @45 trees per hectare and PP would maintain the plants for five years including casualty replacement.
16. Transportation shall not be carried out through forest area.
17. Appropriate activities shall be taken up for social up-liftment of the Region. Funds reserved towards the same shall be utilized through Gram Panchayat.
18. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.
19. Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh Environment Clearance.

B. Standard Conditions

1. Controlled blasting techniques, as and when required, shall be carried out in the day time only.
2. Mining will be carried out as per the approved Mining Plan. In case of any violation of Mining Plan the Environmental Clearance given by SEIAA will stand cancelled.

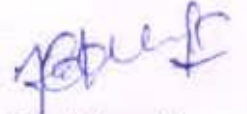
3. Effective safeguard measures, such as regular water sprinkling shall be carried out in critical areas prone to air pollution and having high levels of particulate matter such as loading and unloading point and all transfer points.
4. Where the quarry is in a hilly terrain and where some part of the hill is already cut for quarrying, further hill cutting shall not be done. In such cases, deepening the existing operational area may be preferably done.
5. Precise mining area will be jointly demarcated at site by officials of Mining/Revenue department prior to mining operations for all proposals under consideration.
6. The lease holder shall obtain necessary prior permission of the competent authorities for drawal of requisite quantity of water (surface water and groundwater), if required for the project.
7. Parking of vehicles should not be made on public places.
8. Special Measures shall be adopted to prevent the nearby settlements from the impacts of mining activities. Maintenance of roads through which transportation of minor minerals is to be undertaken, shall be carried-out regularly.
9. Measures for prevention and control of soil erosion and management of silt shall be undertaken.
10. Trenches / garland drains shall be constructed at foot of dumps to arrest silt from being carried to water bodies.
11. The project proponent will ensure necessary protection measures around the mine pit, waste dumps and garland drain.
12. Top soil / solid waste shall be stacked properly with proper slope and adequate safeguards and shall be utilized for backfilling (wherever applicable) for reclamation and rehabilitation of mined out area.
13. Plantation programme shall be carried out as per EMP. Self sustenance of the vegetation should be ensured. No tree-felling shall be done in the leased area, except only with the permission from competent authority.
14. The vehicles transporting minerals shall be covered with a tarpaulin or other suitable enclosures so that no dust particles / fine matters escape during the course of transportation.
15. Project Proponent shall ensure appropriate arrangement for shelter and drinking water for the mine workers.
16. Persons working in dusty areas shall be provided with protective respiratory devices and they shall also be imparted adequate training and information on safety and health aspects.
17. Dispensary facilities for first-aid shall be provided at site.
18. A copy of the environmental clearance shall be submitted by the Project Proponent to the Heads of the Local Bodies, Panchayat and Municipal Bodies, as applicable, in addition to the relevant officers of the Government
19. The Ministry or any other competent authority may alter/modify the conditions or stipulate any further condition in the interest of environment protection.
20. Concealing factual data or submission of false/fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this clearance and attract action under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
21. Any appeal against this prior environmental clearance shall lie with the Green Tribunal, if necessary, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
