The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein it was observed from the Google image that the lease is already excavated for which PP submitted that they have alerted obtained EC from DEIAA issued vide letter no. 2664 dated 15/11/2016 and since their lease validity has expired and the district mining department is not extending the lease validity and thus they have applied for fresh EC. Committee deliberated and recommends that since this case has valid EC and there is no change in the production quantity thus as per MoEF&CC OM no. J-11011/15/2012-IA II (M) dated 20/03/2015, the EC issued earlier is valid and no fresh EC is required at the time of lease renewal"

After detail discussion, it is decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC. However, compliance report of EC conditions as issued by DEIAA to be submitted by PP. Copy to PP and all concerned
