Sub: Case no. 511/2010, Prior Environmental Clearance for 20 MW (viz 1 x 20 MW) (AFBC) captive power plant in its existing premises of sponge iron of 1050 (3 x 350) TPD at village Godwali & Bastali, Tehsil Devassar & Chitrangi, Distt. Singrauli by M/S Trimula Industries Ltd., Singrauli

Prior Environmental Clearance for 20 MW (viz 1 x 20 MW) (AFBC) captive power plant in the existing premises of sponge iron unit at village Godwali & Bastali, Tehsil Devassar & Chitrangi, Distt. Singrauli by M/S Trimula Industries Ltd., Singrauli was accorded (vide our letter no. 843/EPCO-SEIAA/11 dtd 15.12.11). In the condition no. i of Specific Conditions of this prior EC letter, it was mentioned that capacity of existing sponge iron ore should not exceed 350 TPD. Any expansion of sponge iron ore project will require prior Environmental Clearance as per EIA notification, 2006.

Against this EC condition the Proponent represented (vide letter dtd 20.02.12) and requested to make amendment in it. This was discussed in 96th SEIAA meeting dtd 11.06.12 and it has been recorded that "it was felt that this condition was not required in the prior EC letter dtd 15.12.11. Therefore, it was decided to withdraw condition no. i of the Specific Condition of EC letter issued vide letter dtd 15.12.11."

In the light of above mentioned facts, the condition no. i of the Specific Condition of EC letter issued (vide letter no. 843/EPCO-SEIAA/11 dtd 15.12.11), is hereby withdrawn. The other conditions shall remain unchanged. This letter should be treated along with Prior EC letter dtd 15.12.11.
