Sub: Case No. 548/2010 Prior Environmental Clearance for Diaspore & Pyrophyllite mine (Open cast manual /semi mechanized method) in an area of 9.67 ha. for production capacity of Diaspore & Pyrophyllite 1360 TPA & 15530 TPA at Village - Nandanwara, Tehsil - Jatara, Dist. Tikamgarh (MP) by Eastern Minerals, Bhagwanthpura, 5th km Mauranipur Road Jhansi, - 2840001

The case was discussed in 570th SEIAA meeting dtd 07.09.2019 and it has been recorded that

" This is case of Diaspore & Pyrophyllite mine and EC granted in 86th SEIAA meeting dtd. 29.03.2012 vide letter No. 108 /EPCO-SEIAA/12 dtd. 23.04.2012 for valid for 5 years. PP has submitted representation vide Letter Q-9/2019 dtd 04.09.2019 received in SEIAA office dtd. 04.09.2019 in which PP requested for extension of EC period of EC validity for 30 years or life of mine.

As per Point No. 9 – Validity of Environmental Clearance of EIA notification 14th September 2006, it is mentioned that

"The prior environmental clearance granted for a project or activity shall be valid for a period of ten years in the case of River Valley projects (item 1(c) of the Schedule), project life as estimated by Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee subject to a maximum of thirty years for mining projects and five years in the case of all other projects and activities".

As per OM No. J-11011/15/2012-IA.II(M) dated 20.03.2015, it is mentioned that

"It is clarified that the Project Proponent which has valid and substituting EC for there Mining Project i.e under EIA Notification 1994 or EIA Notification 2006 will not be required to obtain fresh EC at the time of renewal of lease. This is subject to the maximum period of validity of EC being for mining for 30 years."

As per above OM and EIA Notification, the Authority has decided to increase the period EC validity for 30 years on same production capacity. The EC conditions given in earlier EC will remain same. Copy to PP & All concerned."


