Sub:-Case No. 498/2009 Prior Environment Clearance for Deori Limestone, Laterite, Ochre & White Clay mine in an area of 23.123 ha. for production capacity of 50000 TPA at Khasra Nos. (as per lease deed) at Village Deori, Tehsil-Maihar, Distt-Satna-M.P. by M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd., N.H.-7, Rewa Road, Raj Nagar, Village Amila Lakhwar, Tehsil Maihar, District Satna (M.P)-485771.

The case was discussed in 328th SEIAA meeting dtd 06.05.16 and it has been recorded

"As per the notification issued by MoEF&CC on 14.09.2006, the policy on transferability of EC is as follows :-

11. Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC):

A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisol Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases

In this particular case, the EC was issued to Mr. Lalit Sehgal vide L.No. 459 dtd. 05.04.2016 for an area of 23.123 ha. at Village Deori, Tehsil-Maihar, Distt-Satna. PP has submitted a letter on 14.04.2016 that the lease has been transferred to M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd. On perusal of the documents of transferability, PP has submitted the NOC of M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd., sanction order of Mineral Resources Department, GoMP regarding transer of lease in favor of M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd. for the remaining lease period on the same terms and conditions as impossed on the previous lessee i.e. Mr. Lalit Sehgal, the documents of formal transfer of lease to M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd. duly executed by Collector, Satna.

After detailed discussions on the MoEF&CC Notification regarding transferability it has been decided to transfer the EC issued on 05.04.2016 in favor of Mr. Lalit Sehgal to M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd. on the same specific and standard conditions for the remaining lease period. Copy to PP and all concerned."

Hence, it was decided to transfer the Prior EC in the name of M/s K.J.S. Cement Ltd., N.H.-7, Rewa Road, Raj Nagar, Village Amila Lakhwar, Tehsil Maihar, District Satna (M.P)-485771 with the same terms & conditions under which the Prior Environmental Clearance was initially granted, and for the same production capacity and validity period.
