After presentation and deliberations it was observed that following sanctioned/proposed mines in the area are forming a cluster which is >25 ha.:-

All the mines of above cluster after their individual valid application in SEIAA & presentation in SEAC for TOR can conduct regional EIA but their EMP should be site specific and will be considered on case to case basis.

Being itos a case of cluster where the total area is > 25 ha. it was decided to consider this case as B-1 and committee recommended to issue standard TOR prescribed by MoEF&CC with following additional TOR:-

- 1. Detailed evacuation plan is to be discussed in the EIA report.
- 2. EIA/EMP is required to be prepared for entire cluster in order to cover all the possible externalities. The report should cover carrying capacity of cluster, transportation and other related issues.
- 3. A list of all the mines located in the cluster along with their production, lease area, status of mine plan, lease period etc for each cluster.
- 4. A satellite Image of the area showing all the mines, mineral evacuation route, all important features, habitation, roads, industry and other mines etc located within 5 km radius of the cluster for each cluster.

Concerned Mining Officer vides letter no.-750, dated: 20/04/2015, has reported that there is 06 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total area-19.090ha including this mine.

The case was presented by the PP and their consultant. During the scrutiny of documents it was observed that there is over writing without authentication is done in the mandatory certificate of Tehsildar. Thus PP was asked to submit fresh certificate from the Tehsildar. The EMP also needs revision. A revised EMP is also to be submitted by the PP.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 1000 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no.349, dated: 01/07/2015, has reported that there is no more mines operating or proposed within 1000 meters around the said mine.

The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure $\pm B\alpha$

- 1. Production of Sand not exceeding 1,20,000 cum/year as per mine plan.
- 2. A bridge is in close proximity (approx. 100 meters) thus safe distance of 100 meters be left from the ML area.

This is case of **Stone Quarry**. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-583, Village-Buranabad, Tehsil-Khachrod, District-Ujjain (MP) 2.00 Ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no.917, dated: 29/11/2014, has reported that there is no more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

The case was presented by the PP and their consultant. During the scrutiny of documents it was observed that there is over writing without authentication is done in the mandatory certificate of Tehsildar. Thus PP was asked to submit fresh certificate from the Tehsildar.

25. Case No. 3632/15 Shri Hari Om Tomar S/o Shri Shiv Singh Tomar, Village-Tamaliya, Tehsil-Jirapur, District-Rajgarh (MP)-465693. PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 1000 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no.479, dated: 06/06/2015, has reported that there is no more mines operating or proposed within 1000 meters around the said mine.

The case was presented by the PP and their consultant. The submission made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable to the committee but scrutiny of documents reveals that in DFO certificate the information about distance from forest boundary is not included. Thus PP was asked to submit the DFO certificate as above.

This is case of **Stone Quarry**. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-394 MIN-2, Village-Nariya Bujurg, Tehsil-Shyamgarh, District-Mandsaur (MP) 2.00 Ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no.-2386, dated: 17/11/2014, has reported that there is 02 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total area-6.00ha including this mine.

The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein it was observed that:

- 1. A water body is in close proximity (approx 500 meters).
- 2. One co-ordinate (provided by PP) of ML area falls inside the factory premise adjacent to the site.
- 3. The two sides of the ML area are surrounded by roads. (Approx. 80 meters and 110 meters respectively)

Considering the above sensitivities, the site is not suitable for mining. The case is therefore not recommended for EC.

27. Case No. 3634/15 Shri Shubhash Sharma S/o Shri Hariram Sharma, Village & Post-Ratibad, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal (MP)-462044. Prior Environment Clearance for approval of Stone Quarry in an area of 2.180 ha. (13,000 cum/year) at Khasra No.-814, 815, 816, Village-Sikendrabad, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal (MP)

This is case of **Stone Quarry**. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-814, 815, 816, Village-Sikendrabad, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal (MP) 2.180 Ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no.----, dated: 22/06/2015, has reported that there is 02 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total area-5.860ha including this mine.

Case was presented by PP and their consultant. During presentation and deliberations, it was observed from the Google image that the site is within 10 Km radios of Van Vihar National Park (a Notified PA) Clearance from NBWL is therefore needed. However, this is not as per the certificate issued by the concerned DFO. Thus it was decided to write by SEAC to Chief Conservator of Forest, Bhopal for reconfirmation of NOC issued by the DFO.

28.<u>DISCUSSION BASED ON INSPECTION REPORT PROPOSED BY SEAC</u>

<u>Case No. – 2685/2015 Shri Alok Chaturvedi Capacity - Partner/Attorney, M/s Bundelkhand Granite, 6th km Sagar Road, Dhadari, P.O. & District-Chhatarpur Stone Quarry Lease Area-3.60 ha., Capacity - 75,000 MTPA, at Village-Khajua, Tehsil-Rajnagar, District-Chhatarpur (M.P.)</u>

Background

This case was discussed in 196th SEAC meeting dated 02/06/2015 wherein during presentation it was observed that a nallah is passing from near the project boundary. After

deliberation committee decided to visit the site to assess the existing status of the mine and the protection measures taken / proposed for conservation of the nallah.

PROJET DETAILS

This is a case of mining of Stone boulder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Khajua, Tehsil-Rajnagar, District-Chhatarpur (M.P.) in 3.60 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1528 dated 09/12/2014 has reported that there is no mine operating /proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

As decided, Dr. Mohini Saxena, Member SEAC visited the site on 24/09/2015. During inspection, Dr. Abhaya K. Saxena, Sr. Scientific Officer, MP Pollution Control Board, Bhopal, Shri. Ramnarayan Tiwari, Patwari (M-09893668499) and Shri C.P.J. John & Shri. Brajesh Panday, mine managers were also present.

This is a mine lease of Stone boulder in an area of 3.60 ha and the ML area is approx. 1.40 Kms away from Khajuraho- Mahoba Road and is connected through a kachha road. The topography of the site is usually flat but undulating at some places of about 10 to 20 meter height. The quantity of top soil in the lease area is very thin. A crusher of approx. 80 tones/hour is also installed near the site (approx. 80 meters outside the lease area) and was under the maintenance at the time of inspection. Two mined pits were seen in the ML area which were having rain water in it and PP proposed that initially, this collected rain water will be utilized for the mining operations.

As per the observation during site visit, the site is on the upstream of Kutne Dam and the FTL is about 400 meters away from the site. The nallah feeding the catchment runoff to the Dam is approx. 100 - 150 meters away from the ML area. PP has informed that for the protection of nallah, a garland drain with settling tank of suitable capacity will be developed all around the site and supernatant water will be used for the plantation and spraying on the hall roads and stone crusher dust.

No mining activities were carrying out at the time of inspection and mine manager informed that since September, 2012 the mine is closed. However water tankers, other machinery and administrative office required for the mining, do exist on the site. No

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forest area could be located visually nearby the mine. PP has already done some plantations (approx 100) in the lease area mainly of Neem, Amla and other trees and has also planted new saplings this rainy season. During site inspection, no other activities could be seen in and around the site.

Following recommendations are made after site visit:-

- 1. The Kachha approach road from ML area to the main connecting road (Khajuraho-Mahoba Road) should be maintained by the PP.
- 2. Garland drains with settling pit of suitable capacity may be provided to avoid any runoff in dam/nallah.
- 3. Thick plantation should be carried out towards dam/nallah.
- 4. The mine should be properly fenced to avoid any incident of human/cattle slipping in to the mined pits.

The report of committee (Annexure-1) was discussed in the meeting and after deliberations, committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure :Aø

- 1. Production of Stone not exceeding 75,000 MTPA/year as per mine plan.
- 2. The Kachha approach road from ML area to the main connecting road (Khajuraho-Mahoba Road) should be maintained by the PP.
- 3. Garland drains with settling pit of suitable capacity may be provided to avoid any runoff in dam/nallah.
- 4. Thick plantation should be carried out towards dam/nallah.
- 5. The mine should be properly fenced to avoid any incident of human/cattle slipping in to the mined pits.
