### STATE EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE MINUTES OF 252th MEETING

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

Jamunia</u> <u>Viran Stone Quarry Lease Area - 2.024 ha., Capacity- 6,000 cum/year at Khasra</u> No.-67, 68, Vill.- Jamunia Viran, Th.-Goharganj, Dist-Raisen (M.P.)

This is case of **Jamunia Viran Stone Quarry**. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-67, 68, Vill. - Jamunia Viran, Th.-Goharganj, Dist-Raisen (M.P.) 2.024 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vides letter no.-54 dated: 20/01/2015 has reported that there are no more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

The case was presented by the PP and their consultant in the 189<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 05/06/2015 wherein it was observed that the site is within 10 Km from the notified PA the Ratapani Abhyaran hence PP is required to obtain comments from the Chief Wild Life Warden of M.P. in prescribed format of MoEF & CC and furnish the same within 01 month for further necessary action in the matter.

PP has submitted the copy of online application made for wild life clearance vides their latter dated 28/10/2015. PP has applied online for wild life clearance with proposal no. FP/MP/MIN/244/2015 and date of submission is 16/10/2015

The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure  $\frac{2}{2}A\alpha$ 

- Production of **Stone** as per mine plan with quantity not exceeding 6,000 cum/year.
- Necessary Wild Life Clearence from NBWL shall be obtained by PP.
- No blasting and crushing is allowed in the ML area. Only manual mining with the help of rock breaking machine is permitted.

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ordinates of mine duly verified by the mining officer as out of four, two co-ordinates are falling on same location.

Thus PP was asked to obtain fresh Tehsildarøs certificate mentioning the aerial distance from the ML area to the interstate boundary. Secondly, land use detailes are not mentioned in the mine plan. Thus PP was also asked to get the land use details duly signed by the mining officer.

Since itøs a case of stone mining where blasting is also proposed which may affect the structural stability of the pond. The EMP submitted by the PP has no mention about the existence of above environmentally sensitive features and their proposed mitigation

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plan. Thus committee decided not to recommend this case for the grant of environmental clearance.

All the mines of above cluster after their individual valid application in SEIAA & presentation in SEAC for TOR can conduct regional EIA but their EMP should be site specific and will be considered on case to case basis.

As decided, Dr. U.R. Singh, Member SEAC and Dr. Abhaya K. Saxena, Sr. Scientific Officer, MP Pollution Control Board, Bhopal & OIC SEAC secretariate visited the site on 29/09/2015. During inspection, and Shri Bhupendra Singh, G.M., Mine Corp and Shri Chandra Sekher, Mine Manager, were also present.

All the above sites are near village- Sunnd which is approximately 2.00 Kms away from the sites. No water body seen in the nearby area except an old mined pit which was having rain water at the time of inspection. The topography of the sites is mainly flat surrounded by hillocks and some part of mining lease of sites is joining hilly area too. One site of same group was notices operational at the time of inspection for which PP has informed that they have obtained EC. A site office near the ML area has also been established by the PP.

The Raisen ó Sanchi road is approx. 7.5 Kms away from the site and the connecting road is a metal road up to village - Server and from Village - Server the site is 2.00 Kms away connected through a Kachha road. The sand stone is approx. 3.00 meters below the surface and out of 3.00 meters, 1.00 meter is the top soil and 2.00 will be waste rocks. The method of mining will be open cast semi mechanized without blasting. DG set of suitable capacity will be used for power requirement of the project. According to PP, the water demand for mining operation will be meet from the water collected in the old mine pit and domestic/ drinking water will be obtained from the village- Sund with the permission of Gram panchayat. No mining activities were being carried out at the time of inspection on

proposed sites. But mining operations were being carried out on other mine of the same group in same area for which EC has been obtained. However, there was not evidence of initiation of plantation in buffer/safety zone around the ML area and top soil was haphazardly mixed with overburden heaps. During site inspection, no other activities could be seen in and around the proposed site. Most of the ML areas is surrounded by hillocks which were almost green, probably because of post monsoon period.

The evacuation of minerals from the Village ó Sund is not possible as the width of road is not enough for movement of heavy loaders and is densely populated by habitants. The PP is developing an alternate route for the evacuation of minerals from the other side of the village ó Sund. This new road will connect Raisen ó Sagar road (approx. 3.5 kms for the site) via village- Naveli (which is about 1.00 Kms from the site) and Village- Mhow Pathrai (another approx 1.5 kms from village Naveli).

### **OBSERVATIONS:**

- As given in Table-1, there are all-together 5 cases of same proponent (Mine Corp) in same area. The total mining lease area and production of all these 5 cases of Mine Corp comes 17.137 ha and 2, 58, 618 cum/year, respectively.
- 2. Case No. 2311/2014 was considered in 198 SEIAA (11/5/15) & 168 SEAC (11/1/15). EC has been issued on 8/6/15 and mine was operational during the time of site visit. However, there was not evidence of initiation of plantation in buffer/safety zone around the ML area and the top soil was haphazardly mixed with overburden heaps.
- **3.** Three cases 2625 / 2015, 2576 / 2015 and 2624 / 2015 recommended by SEAC have been refereed back by SEIAA to consider for ToR on ground of total mining area within 500 m of proposed cases submitted in original application. Subsequently, SEIAA forewarned

information about the total mining area within 500 m. This information is summarized in Table 2 to Table 4 to present comparative statement. **The two figures do not match.** 

- **4.** The 5th Case No **2196**/2014 was recommended in168 (11/5/15) meeting of SEAC. Having observed the veracity of data provided by Mining Officer-Raisen SEIAA has written (as decided in its 225 meeting held on 11/8/15), to Director, Geology and Mining to send a qualified person from his office to ascertain the veracity of data. provided by Mining Officer-Raisen. Since this information is also important for visualizing cumulative scenario in this site visit report too, we were waiting for it. But this has yet not been received. However, the report is submitted as it may not wait for longer time
- **5.** The sand stone is approx. 3.00 meters below the surface and out of 3.00 meters, 1.00 meter is the top soil and 2.00 will be waste rocks. Hence, substantial amount of waste is likely to be generated which needs to be managed.
- **6.** In view of the cumulative impact expected from the production 2, 58, 618 cum/year Sandstone Quarry (Farshy Pather) all FIVE mines proposed by Mine Corp comes in same area, coupled with rate of waste generation, calls for Environmental Impact Assessment leading to a comprehensive Environmental Management plant to address the likely impacts.
- **7.** It is evident from Table-1 that coordinate of Case No. 2576 and Case No (2624) are same.

The report of committee (Annexure-1) was discussed in the meeting and after deliberations, committee decided tha all the three mines are to be considered as B-1 category and EIA may be considered. However before TOR is issued for the individual sites, PP has to submit the precise co-ordinates of the ML area because as per the co-ordinates given for each site there is overlapping of area in two sites and in one case even the two sites have similar co-ordinates. The committee is off the view that PP may be asked to furnish co-ordinates for all the sites duly authenticated by the mining department for issuance of TORs.

Prior Environment Clearance</u> <u>for approval of Basalt Stone & Murrum Quarry in an area of 3.980 ha. (Basalt stone-96,498 & Murram-5,676 cum/year) at Khasra No.-03, Village-Jamanya Jagir, Tehsil-Mhow, District-Indore (MP)</u>

### **Background**

This case was discussed in 210th SEAC meeting dated 25/07/2015 wherein in view of mining area observed in the Google image committee decided to visit the site before decision in the matter so as to ascertain the possible impacts from over all mining activities (if any) in the region.

### PROJET DETAILS

This is a case of mining of Basalt Stone & Murrum Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-03, Village-Jamanya Jagir, Tehsil-Mhow, District-Indore (MP) in **3.980 ha**. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vides letter no.-390 dated: 9/4/2015, has reported that there is no mine operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

As decided, Dr. R. Maheshwari, Member SEAC visited the site on 18/10/2015. During inspection, Dr. Abhaya K. Saxena, Sr. Scientific Officer and Dr. Sunil Sudhakaran, Scientist, MP Pollution Control Board, Bhopal and Shri Karan Thakur, Representing Prithvi Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd., Indore **was** also present.

This is a mine lease of Basalt Stone & Murrum Quarry in an area of 3.980 ha for production capacity of Basalt stone-96,498 & Murram-5,676 cum/year. The ML area is approx. 800 meters away from Agra-Mumbai National Highway and is connected through Metal and kachha road. About 500 meters of approach road is metal road and remaining 300 meters is a kachha road which connects the site.

The topography of the site is hilly with very thin layer of top soil. After top soil, murrum is available followed by basalt stone. The quantity of top soil/murrum in the lease area is of about a meter. A crusher of approx. 200 tones / hour is also proposed to be installed within the ML area. The village Jamanya is approx. 800 meters from the mine site. One mined pits was seen near the ML area which was having rain water in it. PP informed that this collated rain water will be utilized for the mining operation when begins.

A water body namely õSanjay Jalashayö is in the vicinity of this proposed mine which is approx. 1.5 Kms away from the ML area. No mining activities were carrying out at the time

of inspection however, other mining leases having crushers installed were observed on the eastern side of the ML area when approaching the site.

No forest area could be located visually nearby the mine. During site inspection, no other activities could be seen in and around the site. The site is to be properly fenced all around the ML area.

The report of committee (Annexure-2) was discussed in the meeting and after deliberations, committee decided that the EMS and other submissions made by the PP earlier were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure  $\frac{1}{2}A\alpha$ 

- Production as per mine plan not exceeding for Basalt Stone 96,498 cum/year and Murrum 5,676 cum/yera.
- The catchment area of water body (Sanjay Jalashay) is near from the ML area thus garland draind with settling tank of suitable capacity be provided all around the ML area.
- As the site is on a hillock and on one side of the site is a National Highway and on the other side is a village Jamanya thus PP should provide winf breaking wall of 03 meter height all around the ML area.

(R. B. LAL) CHAIRMAN Following standard conditions shall be applicable for the mining projects of minor mineral in addition to the specific conditions:

#### Annexure- 'A'

### **Standard conditions applicable to Stone/Murrum and Soil quarries:**

- The amount towards reclamation of the pit and land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department. The appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
- 2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA
- 3. Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
- 4. Necessary consents shall be obtained from MPPCB and the air/water pollution control measures have to be installed as per the recommendation of MPPCB.
- 5. Curtaining of site shall be done using appropriate media.
- 6. The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining @45 trees per hectare and PP would maintain the plants for five years including casualty replacement. Entire plantation should be carried out in the initial 2-3 years while maintenance and causality replacement be done in subsequent years.
- 7. Transportation shall not be carried out through forest area.
- 8. Appropriate activities shall be taken up for social up-liftment of the area. Funds reserved towards the same shall be utilized through Gram Panchayat.
- 9. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.
- 10. The validity of the EC shall be as per the provisions of EIA Notification subject to the following: Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh Environment Clearance.

### Annexure- 'B'

### Standard conditions applicable for the sand Mine Quarries\*

- 1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
- 2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
- 3. Plantation shall be carried out on the banks for stabilization of the banks.
- 4. The mining activity shall be done manually.
- 5. Heavy vehicles shall not be allowed on the banks for loading of sand.
- 6. The sand shall be transported by small trolleys up to the main transport vehicle.
- 7. Transport vehicles will be covered with taurpoline to minimize dust/sand particle emissions.
- 8. For carrying out mining in proximity to any bridge and/or embankment, appropriate safety zone on upstream as well as on downstream from the periphery of the mining site shall be ensured taking into account the structural parameters, location aspects, flow rate, etc., and no mining shall be carried out in the safety zone.
- 9. No Mining shall be carried out during Monsoon season.
- 10. The depth of mining shall be restricted to 3m or water level, whichever is less.
- 11. No in-stream mining shall be allowed.
- 12. The mining shall be carried out strictly as per the approved mining plan and ensure that the annual replenishment of sand in the mining lease area is sufficient to sustain the mining operations at levels prescribed in the mining plan.
- 13. Established water conveyance channels should not be relocated, straightened, or modified.
- 14. If the stream is dry, the excavation must not proceed beyond the lowest undisturbed elevation of the stream bottom, which is a function of local hydraulics, hydrology, and geomorphology.
- 15. After mining is complete, the edge of the pit should be graded to a 2.5:1 slope in the direction of the flow.
- 16. PP shall take Socio-economic activities in the region through the 'Gram Panchayat'.
- 17. EC will be valid for mine lease period subject to a ceiling of 5 years.
