1.0 **Opening Remarks of the Chairman**

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee (Annexure-1) and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations. The list of participants present during meeting is annexed as Annexure-2.

2.0 Consideration of the Projects

07 proposals (for TOR / EIA deliberations) were invited. Out of these proposals only 03 proposals were presented before the committee. It is decided to hold the 54th meeting on 28th April 2010.

EIA Deliberations:

 Case no. 160/2008 M/s Kamtanath Stone Crusher Udhyog, Prop. Nathuram Jatav, Village-Dang, Tehsil-Gohad, ---Distt. –Bhind (M.P.) <u>For – EIAPresentation</u> Project: Stone Quarry Lease, Village-Dang, tehsil-gohad, ---Dist. Bhind Mining Lease Area-42.63 Ha. Prod. 20,000 TPA.

This being a mining project with lease area between 50 ha to 5 ha is listed at S.N. 1(a) of schedule under 'B' Category of EIA Notification, 2006 and is to be appraised by SEAC.

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TOR was issued vide letter dated 02/09/2008. The applicant presented the salient features of the project EIA / EMP and the public hearing issues were dealt in detail. It was reported that it is an existing mine but presently closed. Method of mining is Open cast and semi-mechanized. It was reported that blasting shall be conducted as per the mining scheme. It was reported that a mobile crusher shall be installed in the

lease area. The nearest habitat is village Dilip Singh Ka Pura about 600 meters from the project boundary. River Vaisali is reported to be at about 2.5 Km from the project boundary. Ultimate depth of mine is 6 meters up to 90 mRL and shall not intersect the GW table.

PP has submitted NOC from forest department which reveals that the forest boundary from the proposed site is about 20 Km from the forest boundary.

After deliberations committee has decided to recommend the case for issue of prior EC, with following special conditions:

- Safe blasting operations shall be carried out at least 400 meters away from any feature (habitat, temple etc.)
- Crusher operations shall be carried out with all preventive measures for controlling air / noise pollution and at least 400 meters away from any feature.
- Green area shall be developed in at least 33% of the total mining area during the lease period as per the proposal submitted. This should include a 9 meters broad green strip along the boundary of the lease area.
- PP shall explore the possibility of using solar energy where ever possible.
- Commitments towards CSR have to be followed strictly.
- Construction of premises of the temple located in the lease area along with appropriate approach road for the villagers has to be taken up immediately as per the commitment.
- Regular health checkup record of the mine workers has to be maintained at site.
- PP has to strictly follow the directions / guidelines issued by MoEF, CPCB and other Govt. Agencies from time to time.
- \circ The dump height shall not exceed 30 meters with a slope angle of 37.5° and after

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every 10 meters terracing shall be done.

- Appropriate bio-logical and technical stabilization shall be carried out for OB.
