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1.0 Opening Remarks of the Chairman

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee (Annexure-1) and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations. The list of participants present during meeting is annexed as Annexure-2.

2.0 Consideration of the Projects

09 proposals (for TOR / EIA deliberations) were invited. Out of these proposals only 07 proposals were presented before the committee. It is decided to hold the 56^{th} meeting on 25^{th} May 2010.

Documents submitted by the PP:

Copy of the plan approved by Town & Country Planning department, Land ownership documents.

The case was earlier presented in the 2nd meeting of SEAC dated 14/05/2008 for construction of residential cum commercial complex. SEAC has raised queries pertaining to the case. PP has presented reply to the queries in this meeting. It was submitted by the PP that the plan for construction of multiplex has been dropped. During presentation PP has agreed for the following issues:

- 1. STP shall be shifted from basement to open area. Part of the (339 KLD) treated effluent shall be used as grey-water for flushing, for which dedicated colour coded pipe line shall be laid.
- 2. Ground water shall not be used under any circumstances for construction or operational phase.
- 3. 15 no. ground water re-charge pits shall be constructed in the premises.
- 4. STP sludge shall be properly managed & shall be used as manure only after digestion.
- 5. PP has also agreed to develop green area in about 35% of total plot area, accordingly plan has been submitted. Dedicated pipe line for irrigation with treated effluent shall be laid.
- 6. All measures for energy conservation shall be adapted including use of solar energy and compliance of ECBC guidelines.
- 7. Design of the structures shall such that it can sustain seismic shocks.
- 8. Municipal solid waste shall be segregated at source in colour-coded bins and shall be

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disposed off as per MSW Rules 2000.

Committee has recommended the case for grant of prior environmental clearance after obtaining following documents from the PP:

- Commitment from Municipal Corporation for supply of water and discharge into sewer line.
- Building Permission from Municipal Corporation.

This being a mining project with lease area between 50 ha to 5 ha is listed at S.N. 1(a) of schedule under 'B' Category of EIA Notification, 2006 and is to be appraised by SEAC.

TOR was issued vide letter dated 05/09/2009. This is an open-cast, mechanized granite mining with lease area of 5.0 Ha and capacity of 12307 m³ per year (32000 T/Y). Nearest village from the lease area is Silpatpura at 500 mts and State highway is at 500 meters from the site. It was reported that Silpatpur PF is at 1.5 Km from the site and Lauri PF is at 9.5 Km from the site. Water requirement is reported to be 9 KLD which shall be drawn from bore-well. The deposits are on hillock with two other mines adjacent to this mine. Common Public Hearing for all the three mines (Case no. 422/09, 423/09 & 456/09) was conducted on dated 08/04/2010. PP has submitted NOC from forest department and gram sabha. Information from Forest department reveals that Ken crocodile Sanctuary is located at about 11.25 Km from the site. On demand of the committee during the meeting, PP has also submitted a notarized affidavit stating the fund allocation towards socio-economic activities and special efforts for taking up plantation in 4.7 ha area within the lease period. Affidavit also commits employment to the local people in accordance to the public hearing issues. After deliberations committee has recommended the case for issue of prior environmental clearance, with following special conditions:

1. Construction of Garland drains shall be taken up around the OB dumps followed by settling tank so as to control the silt during rainy season.

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- 2. PP shall ensure the execution commitments made during the public hearing and that mentioned in the affidavit dated 24/05/10.
- 3. Special efforts shall be made for the afforestation in the area as the area is rocky and scarcely support vegetation.

- 1. Construction of Garland drains shall be taken up around the OB dumps followed by settling tank so as to control the silt during rainy season.
- 2. PP shall ensure the execution commitments made during the public hearing and that mentioned in the affidavit dated 24/05/10.
- 3. Special efforts shall be made for the afforestation in the area as the area is rocky and scarcely support vegetation.

4. 493/2009 M/s M/s Ushma Technologies (P) Ltd. 301, Ever Shine Mall Malad Vivek Road Malad (West) Mumbai (M.S.) - Drug Manufacturing Unit at SEZ Indore, Phase – 1 Industrial Area Pithampur Dist. Dhar (M.P). *EIA Presentation*

As this is a case of manufacturing of bulk drugs located in Industrial Area, it is enlisted at SN 5(f) category B of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 the case has to be appraised by SEAC as per the provisions of the notification. Public Hearing is not required.

The proponent has proposed to manufacture bulk drugs (Cancer drugs) such as, Capecitabine, Imatinib Mesylate etc. Total plot area is reported to be 6000 sq.m. allotted by AKVN Indore, green belt is proposed in 2000 sqm. Water consumption is reported to be 30 KL/day, which shall be supplied by the AKVN. Quantity of effluent generated from scrubber, washing of machines & floor, process, boiler blow down, is reported to be 15 KL /day. ETP has been proposed followed by a RO plant for recycling of waste water.

TOR was issued vide letter dated 18/02/2010. Public hearing was not required as the unit is proposed in SEZ, Pithampur Distt. Dhar (M.P). PP has submitted EIA/EMP in compliance to the issued TOR. After deliberation it was revealed that unit is registered under SSI category with total project cost of Rs 16.46 Crore. It was proposed by the PP during presentation that all types of hazardous wastes shall be disposed off as per the Hazardous Waste Rules 2008 and shall obtain the

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member-ship of Common TSDF, Pithampur. As the propsed site is located in critically polluted area with CEPI between 60- 70 sub-committee has visited the site on dated 07/03/10 and comments from the Officer In-charge (M.P. Pollution Control Board) SEZ Pithampur were also obtained in accordance with MoEF OM dated 25/08/2009. Officer In-charge (M.P. Pollution Control Board) SEZ Pithampur has recommended for grant of prior EC to the unit. During the presentation PP has agreed to locate the ETP away from road and monitor all VOC parameters as desired by the committee. After deliberation committee has sought following information from the PP:

- ➤ To the scale map showing green area in the premises.

 PP has submitted the above later hence the <u>committee has decided to recommend</u> the case for grant of prior EC with general conditions as applicable.
- **5. 270/2009** Shri Ganesh Acid Chemical (P) Ltd. Ward No.1, Mishra Nagar Waraseoni Distt. Balaghat (M.P) Katanghari Manganese Deposit 6.229 Ha at Village Katanghari Tehesil- Lalburra, Distt. Balaghat (M.P) *EIA Presentation*

The case was presented before the committee in the meeting dated 21/12/2009 whereby the examination of public hearing issues revealed that one of the land owner has disagreed to provide his land for mining. Thus committee has asked the PP to submit clear relevant documents. The PP has submitted copy of recommendation of Nayab Tehsildar, Lalbrra Distt. Balaghat dated 17/02/2010, stating compensation to the original land owner. Committee has asked the PP to submit final orders from concerned ADM clearly mentioning the release of land to PP with consent of the original land owner. The case was deferred till submission of the above.

The case being Secondary metallurgical processing industry has been covered under 3(a)(c) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 and has to be appraised by the SEAC. The unit is proposed in Ind. Area - Pithampur, Distt.-Dhar (M.P.), hence public hearing may not be required. Proponent presented the salient features of project and proposed TOR. Total area is 36000 Sqm. out of which 12000 Sqm. will be reserved for the plantation. This is a case of expansion of the exiting unit. Production capacity is as follows:

It was reported that industry will use furnace Oil / CNG as fuel .Water requirement 50 KLD, Source of water supply- AKVN, no industrial effluent will generated from the process. Discharge from the domestic activities shall be 3 KLD which will be treated & disposed through septic tank and soak pit. LNG shall be supplied from GAIL through pipe line.

TOR was issued vide letter dated 05/12/2009. Committee has decided to call the opinion of Regional Officer M.P. pollution Control Board Dhar in compliance to the MoEF OM dated 25/08/2009. After deliberations committee has sought following information / documentation from the PP:

- > Criteria for stack height may be submitted with calculations.
- > Copy of agreement with GAIL for LNG supply.

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- ➤ Commitment from the AKVN for supply of water.
