Mining Method

- Mining of marble blocks is carried out by making the holes by the LD-4 vertically and horizontally. Then holes are matched for cutting purpose followed by putting of diamond chain in to holes for cutting of blocks.
- The blocks are taken from the mine site for further processing of slab cutting. Hired Truck/dumpers are used for transportation of blocks from mine site. Same method will continue in future also.

- Separate benches will create in both soil with weathered marble and marble. Proposed production for the first bench is assumed to be 90% of sizeable block. Soil and weathered rock will be removed by using excavator with tipper combination & will be dumped in the west part.
- Waste is found in the form of weather fractured rock, jointed and un-sized blocks are found to be 10% by volume and will be dumped year wise in eastern side at extra land.
- > During the development and production, the proper shape of pit will be developed and will reach to the RL 399m, while earlier developed RL will be maintained for 408m
- > Settling tank- Pit-1, is located in western part of lease area, has been converted as settling tank.

AIR POLLUTION CONTORL MEASURES

Following measures are suggested to mitigate the impact of mining operation over air environment

- Dust suppression over the haulage roads through water sprinkling on regular basis.
- The approach road is kuchha having length of 1 km from lease area to NH7. No habitations have been observed along this route. Prior to movement of vehicle, water spraying is suggested by tanker fitted tractor by lessee and other mines owners. The frequency may be enhanced in cooperation with other mine owner as the same road is being used by 04 other mine operators.
- Green belt development along the roads (both side 350 trees at each stretch), lease periphery, is strongly recommended to provide a curtain between the boundary and other nearby features.

- Proper maintenance of haulage roads, vehicles and machinery s will be carried out in order to control emissions.
- Regular maintenance of village road being used for transportation of mineral up to highway. However it is suggested that the road should be made black topped with the cooperation of other lease operator under CSR programme
- Use of wet drilling and continuous water spraying during sue of wire saw and cutting of marble
- Dust mask must be provided to all workers working in dusty atmosphere.
- Fine dust from cutting of marble mining is known as serious occupational hazard for the workers which need special precaution during cutting of marble. Hence Regular health monitoring (ones in a year) of workers must be ensured.

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL MEASURES

There is no water course in the lease area. The main drainage of the area is through seasonal Nalla in south direction at 250m distance. The nalla is seasonal and flowing pattern observed in south west direction. The water table in the lease area varies from 375m RL to 371mRL whereas mining will be done up to 399mRL depth thus ground water table will not be touched during conceptual period. Hence ground water profile will not have any significant impact. During lease period out of 2.0 ha excavated area, 1.0 ha area will be converted as a water reservoir. Accumulated rainwater in the working pit may be used for agricultural purpose through pumping to settling tank.

Following measures will be taken to avoid accumulation of water in lease area:

- ➤ Pump having adequate capacity will be installed to lift accumulated rain water from working pit to the setting tank.
- ➤ Old Pit No. 1 which is located at North West side of the lease area may be converted as settling tank. Exhausted pit of 1.0 ha will be converted as water reservoir and volume of the reservoir will be 3,70,00 cum
- ➤ Garland drain will be made in boundary covering northern, southern and eastern part, western part direction side to prevent siltation in to nalla. Following drain are suggested:
- ➤ Garland drain no.-1 W & S direction measuring 210 mt L X 0.5mt D
- ➤ Garland drain no.2 ó N & E direction measuring 350 mt L X 0.5mt D
- ➤ Garland drain no.-3 N direction measuring 110 mt L X 0.5mt D
- " All garland drain will be connected to settling tank and water will be used for dust suppuration and agricultural purpose.

- " Quality of water accumulated in the working pit and in settling tank must be checked during pre and post monsoon.
- It shall be ensured that silt content in the mines discharge should be kept minimum.
- " It shall be ensured that quality of drinking water for the worker is hygienic and good sanitation system should be made available.

NOISE POLLUTION CONTROL MEASURES

Following management practices have been observed for the present operation.

- " Hydraulic drills should be used for drilling;
- " All moving & Non-moving parts should be properly lubricated and fastened; and
- " A thick tree belt shall be provided in phased manner around the periphery of the mine to screen the noise;
- " Proper maintenance of noise generating machinery including transport vehicles also
- " Provision of silencers to modulate the noise generated by machines.
- " Provision of protective devices like ear muffs/ear plugs;
- " Provision of sound insulated chambers for the workers deployed on machines producing higher levels of noise like gali toda, drills etc; and
- " Reducing the exposure time of workers experiencing higher noise levels."

The EIA/EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:
