1. **Case No. – 2982/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Laterite & Ochre Mine** in an area of - 7.33 Ha. Capacity - 67,611 TPA, at Khasra no.- Block A: 122/3 Part, 122/4 Part, and 147/2 Part & Block B: 125 Part, Vill.-Dharampura, Teh.-Sihora, District-Jabalpur (M.P.) by Mr. Abhiudya Agarwal (Authorized Signatory), M/s Geomin Industries Pvt. Ltd., 270, Garha Fatak, Jabalpur (M.P.) - 482002

A. This is a project pertaining to mining of Laterite Mine in MLA of 7.33 ha The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. and more than 250 m from the forest boundary. The interstate boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Village - Dharampura, Tehsil - Sihora, District - Jabalpur, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-2' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of comprehensive EMP for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease up to 30 years by Govt. of MP Minerals Resource Department vide order (No.3-22/2013/12-2 dtd.19.9.2013) with production capacity of 67611 TPA.

B. It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Geomin Industries Pvt. Ltd. This is a case of new mining lease. The Mining Plan with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM, Office of Regional Controller of Mines,

Jabalpur (vide Letter No. MP/Jabalpur/Laterite/MPLN/G-13/13-14/6043 dtd. 30.10.2014).

- (1) The case was recommended for prior EC in 55th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 15.10.2016 with 11 special conditions.
- (2) The case was then discussed in 386th SEIAA meeting dtd. 17.11.2016 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (3) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 3000 trees shall be planted covering an area of 2.65 ha under plantation during first year.
- (4) It was noted that the water requirement is 10.20 KLD (3.0 KLD Dust Suppression + 6.75 KLD Plantation + 0.45 KLD Drinking purpose), which shall be met by nearby village, Pit water and Borewell/Dug well.
- (5) PP ensured that the following during presentation:
 - i. A notched area of 20 m in the North - West direction of mining lease boundary shall be demarcated as no mining zone and a green belt with two row plantation shall be developed in the no mining zone.
 - ii. Demarcate 100 m as no mining from the canal in consultation with Mining Officer and Executive Engineer, Water Resource Department.
 - iii. The road connecting mining site to Hirdayanagar shall not be used for transportation.
 - iv. Approach road from mine site to junction of Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority (MPRRDA) road shall be constructed as Pakka road and maintained on regular basis in consultation with EE, MPRRDA.
 - v. Two row plantation shall be carried out on either side of the road.
 - vi. Water requirement for plantation purpose shall be ensured in consultation with local bodies (Gram Panchayat).
 - vii. During presentation, it was revealed that there are high contents of fluoride and total dissolved solids in the nearby ground water sources. Concerned department shall be informed regarding quality of water to take remedial measures.
- (6) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 55th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 15.10.2016, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided that PP shall submit the following:-
 - I. Detailed yearwise excavation and backfilling management plan.
 - II. Details of Borewell/ Handpump/ Dugwell in study area within 5 km alongwith the depth of water table.
 - III. Management Plan mentioning the number of settling tanks and size of Garland drain in the ML area.
 - IV. Report on measures taken for prevention of dust emissions during excavation, loading and unloading during transportation of material.
