Committee after perusal of the documents submitted by the PP observed that according to the revised operational production plan only 40606 Sq.m area is available for the mining activities (19871 Sq.m area is deducted due to existence of bridge and submergence in the water + 19543 Sq.m of area deducted due to confluence of other river). As per approve mining plan the sanctioned depth of the lease is 2.5 m. Thus total volume of sand that can be evacuated from this lease is 1,01,515 cum/year. Committee after deliberations decided that, only 40606 Sq.m area is minable after deducting the submerged area due to bridge and joining of another river only 1,01,515 cum/year sand can be evacuated. "Based on the recommendation of 59<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd. 11.11.2016 and the query response submitted and discussed in 390<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 02.12.2016, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II:-

- (i). PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.

- (vii). A petition (OA 404/2016, MA 758/2016, MA 920/2016 & MA 1099/2016) has been filed before the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench) New Delhi where MP-SEIAA is one of the respondent. No mining activity shall commence of the site till the final order of the Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench New Delhi in the said petition. Any order by the Hon'ble NGT shall be binding to PP. Mining Officer Hoshangabad should strictly monitor no mining activity from the leased area till the final order of Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench New Delhi.
- (viii). SEAC has put a condition for obtaining Wild Life Clearance from NBWL and PP has submitted on-line application also. No mining activity shall commence till the Wild Life Clearance is given by the National Board for Wild Life. The OM dated 02.12.2009 shall be applicable in this particular case.
