Preeti Bhati, 5/5, Urdupura, Rassi Gali, Ujjain (M.P.) on 07-12-2016 PP has not applied for the transfer of EC during this period (almost 4 years). It appears to be a case of violation. PP may be called for clarification.

The case was discussed in 665th SEIAA meeting dated 06.03.2021 and it was recorded that......

The case was scheduled for presentation, but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier PP was also absent in the SEAC 479th meeting dated 11/02/2021SEAC & 477th meeting dated 30/01/2021. Committee decided that since sufficient opportunities has been given to the PP for appraisal of their case but PP remains absent thus committee decided that case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project As per above observation of SEAC, it has been decided to delist the case on the condition that if PP intends to present the case in SEIAA, it will then be relisted for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.

PP has submitted required documents vide dated 24.03.2021 received in SEIAA Office 27.03.2021 to relist the case as PP is now ready to present their case in SEAC. Considering the request of PP, it was decided to relist the case and send the relevant case file to SEAC for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.

9. Case no. 5611/2017 - Prior Environmental Clearance for Granite Block in an area of 9.58 Ha. for production capacity of 1517 cum per annum at Village- Thangaon, Tehsil - Kotma, Dist. - Anuppur (MP) by M/s Shri Radheshyam Minerals, Khedia Bhawan, P.O. Bijuri, Dist. - Anuppur, MP - 484440.

Prior EC granted in 485th SEIAA meeting dated 18-05-2018. Prior EC issued vide letter no. 942-43/SEIAA/18 dated 02.06.2018.

PP vide letter dtd. 25.06.2021 requested for amendment in the prior EC issued on 02.06.2018 for inclusion of OB (unsized block) as per mine plan. However in all the documents submitted by PP the production capacity of Granite Block is mentioned as 1517 cum/year. PP has not mentioned in Form - 1 about unsized block as OB.

PP also mentioned that the orders have been issued recently for the same in Case No. 5768/2018 and 5769/2018.

SEIAA issued the permission for inclusion of overburden unsized block generated during mining of granite vide letter 2777 dtd. 08.09.2020 in case no. 5768/2018 and vide letter no. 1780 dtd. 17.07.2020 (Case 633rd dtd. 21.08.2020) in case no. 5769/2018 dtd. 08.09.2020 (625th SEIAA dtd. 10.07.2020).

PP submitted the Affidavit vide letter dtd. 01.07.2021 that no mining operation has been carried out at the mine site and also mentioned that the permission given by SEIAA in the case no. 5768 & 5769 on the basis of offline application.

In the MoEF&CC OM dated 18.06.2018, in para 2, it is recorded that :-

"2. The matter has been examined in the Ministry and it is submitted that mining projects including dump mining, overburden mining etc. do require the prior Environmental Clearance as per the provision of Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification 2006. Therefore it is clarified that as per the provision of the EIA

Notification 2006, the mining project stated in the schedule require prior environmental clearance irrespective of the size of the mine lease area and type of mineral including over burden and dump mining."

After detailed discussion, it is observed that SEIAA has permitted offline to sale overburden un sized block generated during mining operation in the case no. 5768/2018 issued vide letter no. 2777 dated 08.09.2020 and in the case no. 5769/2018 issued vide letter no. 1780 dtd. 17.07.2020. It was also observed that, as per the Office Memorandum dated 11.06.2019 of MoEF & CC, Gol, in both cases, PPs have not applied through online application on Parivesh Portal. Therefore it is decided that Prior EC's of the above cases no. 5768/2018 & 5769/2018 shall be kept in abeyance. All three PPs may be asked for clarification as well as submission of applications online through Parivesh Portal.

10. Case No:- 8370/2021: Prior Environmental Clearance for Stone Quarry in an area of 2.320 ha. (150005 cum per annum) (Khasra No. 13h), Village - Lakhanpura, Tehsil - Dabra, Dist. Gwalior (MP) by M/s Hardoul Granite through Prop. Smt. Krishna Yadav W/o Shri Ashok Singh Yadav, 108, Bankers Colony, Thatipur, Dist. Gwalior, MP.

PP has requested vide letter dtd. 07.07.2021 received in SEIAA office on 07.07.2021 regarding Correction in the ToR letter.

"The ToR letter issued by SEIAA for the Stone Quarry in an area of 2.320 ha. (150005 cum per annum) (Khasra No. 13h), Village - Lakhanpura, Tehsil - Dabra, Dist. Gwalior (MP) vide letter no. 906 dtd 24.05.21.

The Proponent (vide letter dtd 07.07.21 received in SEIAA office on 07.07.21) informed that the ToR letter issued by SEIAA is the name of Smt. Krishna Yadav, W/o Shri Ashok Singh Yadav instead of M/s Hardoul Granite and requested for correction accordingly in the ToR letter issued earlier (dtd. 24.05.21).

In the title of the ToR letter issued to PP vide no. 906/SEIAA/21 dtd 24.05.21 "Smt. Krishna Yadav. W/o Shri Ashok Singh Yadav 108, Bankers Colony, Thatipur, Dist. Gwalior, MP" should be read as "M/s Hardoul Granite, Proprietor, Smt. Krishna Yadav, W/o Shri Ashok Singh Yadav, 108, Bankers Colony, Thatipur, Dist. Gwalior, MP".

After detailed discussion, it is decided to change of name of the project which should be written as "M/s Hardoul Granite". All the conditions mentioned in the ToR letter (dtd 24.05.21) shall remain unchanged. Copy to all concerned.

11. Case No:- 6662/2019 Prior Environmental Clearance for Pipra Flagstone Quarry in an area of 1.759 ha. (2970 cum per annum) (Khasra No. 132/1KA2), Village - Pipra, Tehsil - Unchehra, Dist. - Satna, (MP) by Shri Omprakash Yadav S/o Shri Bhagwan Prasad Yadav, Village - Bharuhara, Tehsil - Unchehra, Dist. - Satna, MP – 485661.

The EC was granted in 588th SEIAA meeting dtd 12.12.2019 and EC issued to PP vide Letter No. 3824 dated 07.01.2020.

Shri Gorelal Tamrakar has complained and submitted with all supporting documents against the decision of SEIAA vide application dated 18-03-2020 for review as the Case No. STA/16/36 has been rejected by DEIAA vide letter No.2869/Khanij/2017 dated 26.09.17 due to the objection raised by Forest Dept, Satna vide their letter No 6345 dtd 01.08.2016 stating that the forest route has been utilized for transportation.

DFO, Satna vide their letter No 1284 dtd 01.02.2020 has requested SEIAA to revoke the EC issued to Shri Omprakash Yadav for the Khasra No 132/1 ka / 1 area 1.759 ha Village Pipra, Tehsil Unchehra, District Satna.

After reviewing the documents submitted by Shri Gorelal Tamrakar it appears that Shri Omprakash Yadav has submitted false NOC of DFO, Satna vide their letter No 1111 dtd 04.06.2016, which is a gross violation of regulatory ethics and attract the following provisions of EIA notification 2006, Para "8" (vi):

"Deliberate concealment and/or submission of false or misleading information or data which is material to screening or scoping or appraisal or decision on the application shall make the application liable for rejection, and cancellation of prior environmental clearance granted on that basis. Rejection of an application or cancellation of a prior environmental clearance already granted, on such ground, shall be decided by the regulatory authority, after giving a personal hearing to the applicant, and following the principles of natural justice."

After detailed discussion, it is decided that the prior EC issued to PP vide letter no. 3824-25/SEIAA/20 dated 07.01.2020 to Shri Omprakash Yadav for Khasra No 132/1 ka / 1 area 1.759 ha Village Pipra, Tehsil Unchehra, District Satna shall be kept in abeyance. PP may be called for clarification in the next meeting of SEIAA.
