The M/s Krupa Wastage through Partner Shri Sumit Pandey submitted the case to the SEIAA vide proposal no. Moreover, Collector Office (Praman-Patra) issued vide letter no. 4236 dated: 03.09.2020 has reported that there are no more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine hence this case was appraised as Category- B-2.

Considering above facts committee observed that SEAC recommended the case as per the provisions stipulated in the EIA Notification, 2006 and complaint with above justification may be sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action.

In addition to above, a copy of the complaint already sent to Collector, Singrauli and Field Director, Sanjay Tiger Reserve vide No. dated 1073 dated 01.06.2021 for examine the factual status and their comments.

In response to above complaint, point wise information received from Collector, Singrauli vide letter No 3152 dtd 23.06.2021 are as follows:-

- As per DFO, Singrauli letter dated 01.05.18 the proposed mining site is 15 km away from forest boundary.
- As per Tehsildar, Chitrangi letter dated 16.04.18 the proposed mining site is 02 km is away from Son-Ghariyal WLS.
- As per Field Director, Sanjay Gandhi Tiger Reserve letter dated 07.03.18 the proposed mining site is 2.138 km is away from Son-Ghariyal WLS and 1.138 km away from Notified ESZ of Son-Ghariyal WLS.
- As per In-charge Forest Officer, Mirzapur Forest Division, U.P. letter dated 16.05.21, the arial distance from the proposed mining site is 1.740 km away from Kaimur WLS, U.P. and 1.0 km away from Notified ESZ of Kaimur WLS U.P.
- 5. The proposed mining site falling within the radius of 10 km from the interstate boundary. However, as per the MoEF&CC notification no. SO. 141(E) dated 15.01.2016 stated that general condition shall apply except: "River bed mining project on account of interstate boundary".
