1. **Case No. 8610/2021:** Prior Environment Clearance for Stone Quarry (Opencast semi-mechanized Method) in an area of 2.0 ha. for production capacity of 18810 cum per annum at Khasra No. 239/1/min-2, at Village - Manpura, Tehsil - Shamgarh, Dist. Mandsaur (MP) by Shri Anil Kumar s/o Devilal Chandel Residence Bhanpura Road, Garoth- Tehsil Garoth, District Mandsaur (M.P.) **Regarding transfer of EC** in the name of Shri Prathviraj Singh S/o Shri Ranjeet Singh, Village - Guradiya Mata, Dist. Mandsaur, (MP)

- (1) PP had applied in Form-7 for transfer of Prior Environmental Clearance for Stone Quarry in an area of 2.0 ha. for production capacity of 18810 cum per annum at Khasra No. 239/1/min-2, at Village - Manpura, Tehsil - Shamgarh, Dist. Mandsaur (MP) by Shri Prathviraj Singh S/o Shri Ranjeet Singh, Village - Guradiya Mata, Dist. Mandsaur, MP
- (2) The Prior Environmental Clearance was issued by DEIAA Mandsaur vide letter No. DEIAA/ 2016/ 81, dated 30.05.2016 in the name of Shri Anil Kumar s/o

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Devilal Chandel Residence Bhanpura Road, Garoth- Tehsil Garoth, District Mandsaur (M.P.).

- (3) It is noted that in support of his request the PP has submitted the following documents:

Mandsaur, (MP)** and mentioning that no legal action/ credible action has been initiated against the leasee till date.
 - (ii) **Notarized affidavit** of **Shri Prathviraj Singh S/o Shri Ranjeet Singh, Village - Guradiya Mata, Dist. Mandsaur, (MP)** mentioning that no legal action/ credible action has been initiated against the mine till date and commitment to comply all the standard and specific conditions stipulated in the prior EC issued.

- (4) It is noted that in EIA Notification 2006 as per **Para-11 Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC)** there is a provision of transferring the EC.


Para-11:- A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases.

After detailed discussion, it was found that the mine site is not included in District Survey Report. Hence, it is decided that the case will be considered after receiving certificate of Mining Officer ensuring that the proposed mine shall be included in the updated DSR.

2. **Case No 7527/2020:** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Stone Quarry (Opencast Manual / Semi Mechanized Method)** in an area of 2.50 ha. for expansion of production capacity from 26460 to 52770 cum per annum at Khasra No. 202 at Village - Belkhedi, Tehsil - Seoni, Dist. Seoni (MP) by M/s Gulmohar Stone Crusher,


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Partner, Shri Anurag Chaturmohta & Shri Pranay Jain, Ward No. 18, Chaturmohta Hospital, Dist. Balaghat, MP – 480661.

The case was recommended for EC in 502nd SEAC meeting dated 06.07.2021.

After that, the case was discussed in 677th SEIAA meeting dated 26.06.21 and it was recorded as

After detailed discussion, it was decided to call for following information from PP within 15 Days:

- i. Revised detailed plantation plan in consultation with Forest Department along with implementation programme.
- ii. Revised detailed CSR activities identifying the local need of village in consultation with Gram Panchayat.

In reference to above, it is noted that the submissions of replies received at SEIAA office vide letter dated 18.08.2021 was not signed by Project Proponent. Hence, the case is hereby differed.

This case was recommended in 500th SEAC meeting dated 08.04.2021 and it was recorded that.....

".....PP's reply not received till date and it appears that PP is not interested to continue with the project. Since the tenure of SEAC will be over on 09th April, 2021 and all such cases which are pending at SEAC will become category-I cases in the absence of SEAC. Thus case file is being sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action please.."

In context of above it has been decided to delist the case from MPSEIAA on the basis of the tenure of SEIAA will be over on 09th April, 2021 as per EIA Notification 2006 & its amendment" In the absence of a duly constituted SEIAA or SEAC, a Category 'B' project shall be treated as a Category 'A' project; Copy to PP and all concerned..

PP has submitted required documents vide letter dated. 30.07.2021 received in SEIAA Office on 30.07.2021 and requested to relist the case by showing interest to present their case in SEAC. Considering the request of PP, it was decided to relist the case and technical file send to SEAC for appraisal.

"PP vide letter dtd. 01.07.2021 received in SEIAA office on 02.07.2021 has requested to relist the case. However, the desired information by SEAC in 453rd meeting dtd 28.08.2020 not submitted by PP. It was decided that the case shall be considered for relisting after the submission of the desired information within one month."

PP has submitted information/ status of other sanctioned, operated and non operated mines which are located within 500m periphery of the proposed mine duly certified by Mining Officer, District Jhabua vide letter No 1044 dated 13.08.21. It is noted that the total area of the cluster of mines having 4.85 ha which comes under Category -B2. 
As above the total area including the proposed mine is exceeding 5.00 ha, hence the case is falling under B1 category.

After detailed discussion and deliberation, it was decided that write a letter to the Collector, Alirajpur for constitution of committee comprising of Mining Officer and Revenue Officer of District - Alirajpur to carry out the site inspection to verify the status of



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other sanction & operated mines falling within 500 m periphery of the proposed mine. The committee shall submit a report through Collector, Alirajpur within 15 days. Copy to PP."


Accordingly, PP has submitted a copy of letter of the Collector, District Alirajpur dated 10.08.2021 mentioning the site inspection by committee constituted by him that there is no other operating or sanctioned mines located within the 500m periphery of the proposed mine. It is found that the case will be considered in Category-B2.

After detailed discussion and perusal of recommendations of 498th SEAC meeting dated 06.04.2021, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following additional conditions:-

- i. Before commencing mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of cautionary signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals.
- ii. The mining activity should be carried out as per the provisions given in the Approved Mining Plan.
- iii. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table, approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- iv. PP shall ensure installation of cautionary signages on transportation routes for avoidance of accidents.
- v. Proper landscape planning should be done along with its sincere implementation.
- vi. PP shall ensure to get the details incorporated as per sanctioned lease/EC in the DSR approved by the Directorate of Geology & Mining, Govt. of MP, failing which this EC shall be revoked.
- vii. PP shall ensure to construct garland drains with settling tanks all around the lease area and regular cleaning & maintenance of the same shall be carried out by PP.

- xii. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as per approved Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
- xiii. PP must ensure the implementation of following activities with separate budget provisions under CER:
 - ❖ Renovation of Govt. Primary School at village Utti.
 - ❖ Development of grazing land.

Also, PP shall ensure contribution of funds under Jal Jeevan Mission in consultation with Janpad Panchayat and PHED. PP shall give preference to develop/provide appropriate infrastructural facilities in schools or anganwadis of above village. The modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Collector and Gram Panchayat.


- xiv. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report, plantation and CER activity report along with photographs of all activities in MP-SEIAA. If PP is failed to upload or submit two consecutive half yearly compliance reports of EC conditions to concerned authority (SEIAA and Regional Office, MoEF&CC, GoI, Bhopal) than prior environmental clearance issued to PP will automatically be treated as cancelled/ revoked as per SEIAA Office Memorandum No. 930/SEIAA/2019 dated 30.05.2019.
- xv. In case the ownership is changed, EC should be immediately transferred to the new owner. Without transfer of EC, the EC stands in abeyance till the transfer of EC to the new owner is approved by SEIAA.



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


This case was EC granted in 658th SEIAA meeting dated 09.02.2021 and it was recorded that

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for Stone Quarry (opencast semi mechanized method) in an area of 4.00 ha. for production capacity of 1,800 cum per annum at Khasra No. 01 at Village - Semrakhedi, Tehsil - Deori, Dist. Sagar (MP) for the lease period to Shri Amit Kumar Jain, H.No. 181, Mahakali Ward, Deori, Dist. Sagar, MP.

After detail discussion, it was observed that the Assistant Mining Officer, Sagar vide letter No. 03 dated 02.01.2021 informed that there are 02 other mines area of 4.70 ha. falling under 500 m. radius of the existing mine, hence forming a cluster of 8.70 ha. As per the MoEF&CC, OM dated 12.12.2018 the case is falling under B1 - category. Therefore the EC granted in 658th SEIAA meeting dated 09.02.2021 shall not be issued, it will be kept in hold. It is


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decided that, PP may call for clarification as per certification given by Assistant Mining Officer, Sagar.

In above context, PP has submitted a copy of letter of the Collector, District Sagar dated 26.08.21 mentioning that there is no other operating or sanctioned mines located within the 500m periphery of the proposed mine.

On the basis of the above information presented by PP, it is clear that total area of the cluster becomes more than 5.0 ha and this case shall be considered under Category - B1 as per provision of EIA Notification, 2006 and its subsequent amendments.

It is decided that, the case is hereby closed and PP may apply afresh online application for ToR on Parivesh Portal. Copy to all concerned.



1. This is case of Building and construction project institute of Medical Sciences is a medical research private university. It is Medical College cum Hospital (800 bedded).
