".....The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein as per Google image based on coordinates provided by PP, committee observed that the most parts of the lease is in close proximity of huge water body in the north side and nearby water channel in the eastern side of the lease. The proposed depth of mining is 18 meters in 1.00 ha land and possibility of water inundation can not be ruled out considering blasting for production of 48640 cum of stone. Thus, committee after deliberation recommends that this case can not be considered for grant EC and file may be sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action".

As per above observation of SEAC, it has been decided to reject the case as EC can not be considered looking to environmental sensitivity. Copy to PP and all concerned.
