Minutes of the 23rd SEIAA Meeting held on 29th October, 2009

The 23rd meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 29th October, 2009 at 11.30 A M at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(A) Cases recommended for Environmental Clearance by SEAC

 M/s Shrijee minerals, Proprietor, Shri Deepak Gupta, Jhanda Bazar, Sihora, Jabalpur, Laterite, ochre & white clay mine 18.66 hact. at vill- Dundi Teh- Sihora, Distt- Jabalpur M.P. case no 186/2008.

The above case was recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance. While scrutinizing the documents submitted by the project proponent SEIAA noticed the following:-

(i) The NOC issued by Forest Deptt. does not mention the distance of Mining Lease area from the forest boundary.

Hence it was decided to send the above case back to SEAC for reconsideration on the above ground.

2. Ghanshyam Das Mahawar, 95 Cantt.Sadar, Jabalpur, Fireclay, Laterite & silica's sand mine 8.00 hact.at vill-Pindrai, Teh-Dhimarkhera, Distt- Katni M.P. *case no 184/2008.*

The above case was recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance. While scrutinizing the documents it was observed that the public hearing report submitted by the Addl. Collector mentioned that the mining lease was accorded for 10 years from 1994 to 2004 and presently is under the process of renewal. The renewed mining lease documents have not be submitted by the project proponent.

Hence it was decided to send the case back to SEAC for reconsideration on the above ground.

3. Vinod Kumar Gupta, Gupta Sadan Lakhera, Vivekanand Ward Katni M.P., Dolomite/Marble Deposit mine 14.39 ha. at vill- Kachhargaon, Teh-Bahoriband, Katni- M.P, case no 252/2008.

The above case was recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord Environmental Clearance to the above project.

4. Ram Lubhaya Sehgal, Rewa Road, Maihar, Satna -M.P, Lime stone mine 9.008 ha. at village Batia, Teh-Maihar, Satna- M.P. *case no 250/2008.*

The above case was recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord Environmental Clearance to the above project.

(B) Cases recommended by SEAC for environmental clearance after reconsideration

1. M/s Shanti realty Pvt Ltd, 3, Janki Nagar, Annex A.B. Road, Indore – M.P., High-rise multi storied residential project at Village Nipaniya, Indore – M.P **Case no.283/2009.**

The above case was recommended for Environmental Clearance by SEAC after reconsideration on the following grounds:-

- (i) Source of 260 KLD water requirement.
- (ii) Permission to discharge 160 KLD treated waste water in to public sever.
- (iii) Documents indicating the ownership of land in revenue record.

In support of the above point (i) & (ii) the Project Proponent has submitted a letter issued by City Planner, Municipal Corporation, Indore giving a commitment to provide water to the project and accommodate the treated waste water in future when ever the 3rd phase of Narmada Project is commissioned.

SEIAA decided to reject the case Project Proponents can apply again as soon as the water supply and sewage disposal facility is put in place under 3rd phase of Narmada Project.
